The Children We've Helped

"This student excels both academically and athletically and was diagnosed with brain cancer this fall. The student lives with his mother and younger sister, and due to the nature of the cancer, his mother had to quit her job in order to take care of her son. He underwent surgery to remove the tumor and was then at a hospital for several months for treatment. Now that the student is back with us, he is unable to do many of the things he did previously. He identified that playing board games is away to interact with his peers again and also to regain some cognitive functioning that was impacted by surgery and radiation. The board games that he has requested are Settlers of Catan, Myth, SmallWorld and Ticket to Ride."

We just sent the teacher a Walmart gift card so the boy could get his games.
